**Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd works.**

**To allow maintenance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of South Street, Barming.**

**A closure is planned from 23.00 hours on 9th March 2024, with estimated completion by 04.00 hours on 11th March 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL815PWS1-42-17-090324-01 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)**

**South Street will be closed in the vicinity of the railway bridge, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.**

**The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while maintenance works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.**

**There is no alternative route for this closure, however, residential access will be maintained at all times when it is safe to do so.**

**Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
