(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2024

Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd works.

To allow maintenance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of South Street, Barming.

A closure is planned from 23.00 hours on 9th March 2024, with estimated completion by 04.00 hours on 11th March 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL815PWS1-42-17-090324-01 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

South Street will be closed in the vicinity of the railway bridge, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while maintenance works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.

There is no alternative route for this closure, however, residential access will be maintained at all times when it is safe to do so.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
