Beverley Road, Maidstone
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2023

To allow road crossing and joint bay works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Beverley Road, Maidstone.

A closure is planned from 30th January 2023, with estimated completion by 3rd February 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50090273503-01 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Beverley Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 66, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while road crossing and joint bay works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Beverley Road, A26 Tonbridge Road, B2246 Fountain Lane, Heath Road and vice versa.
